

Weather/storms

Recent Opinion surveys have revealed that many members now prefer local travel over international travel, for a variety of reasons.

The July Opinion survey explored this further, finding that:

- >> 72% of members like to explore parts of regional WA at least once every year.
- **Nature-based holidays** are very appealing to 1 in every 2 members.
- **Camping** is a popular activity for many members, in particular for families with children under the age of 18 years.
