

Members told us which road rules they find the most confusing or those which they often see not being followed correctly.

On Perth roads:

On regional roads:

- Overtaking and passing
- Speeding
- Tailgating

"A huge number of drivers leaving a roundabout do not indicate correctly."

"People don't know how to drive around heavy vehicles."

"I think our merging is the worst and no ones uses their indicators anymore."

Did you know?

- **»** For 58% of members, **overcrowding** is a major consideration when planning holidays, with many avoiding school holidays and peak season for travel.
- **Social media** is the main source of information about events and things to do in WA.
- While many members prefer DIY to manage any home repairs, over half of all members have used the services of an electrician or plumber in the last 2 years.
- 7 in every 10 members support an AFL team, with the Eagles and Dockers being the most popular.
