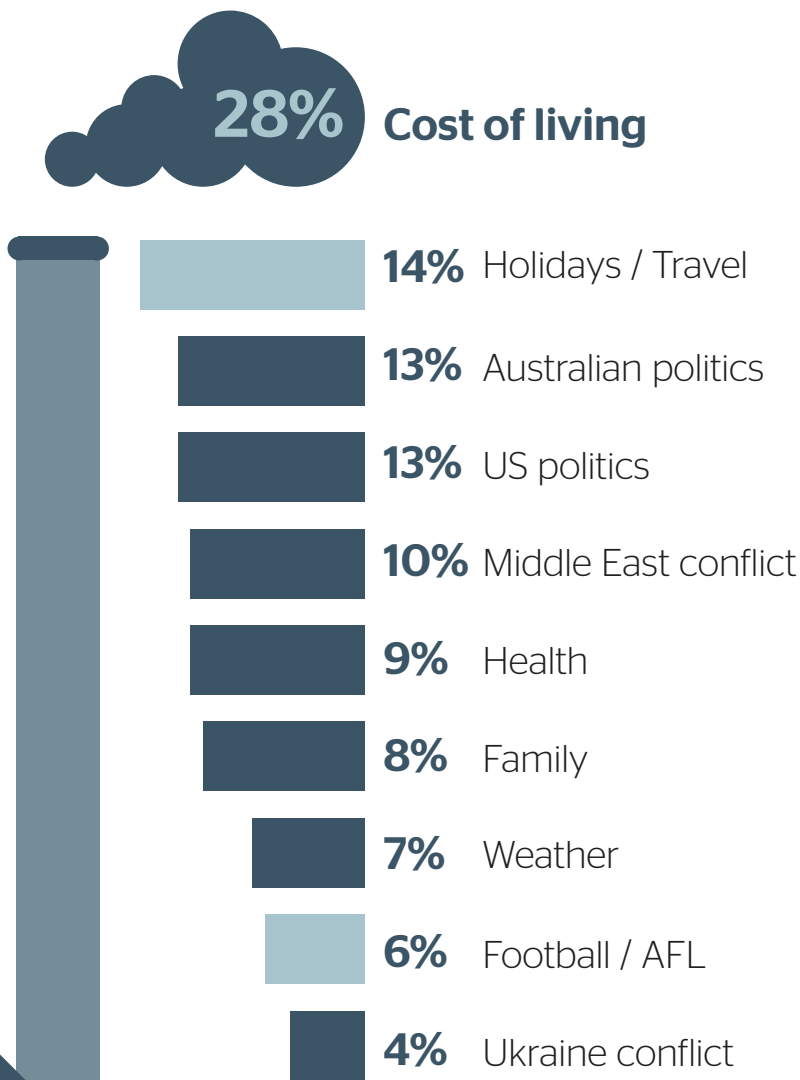

Car Safety Features

- » Blind spot monitoring
- » Cruise control / Adaptive cruise control
