

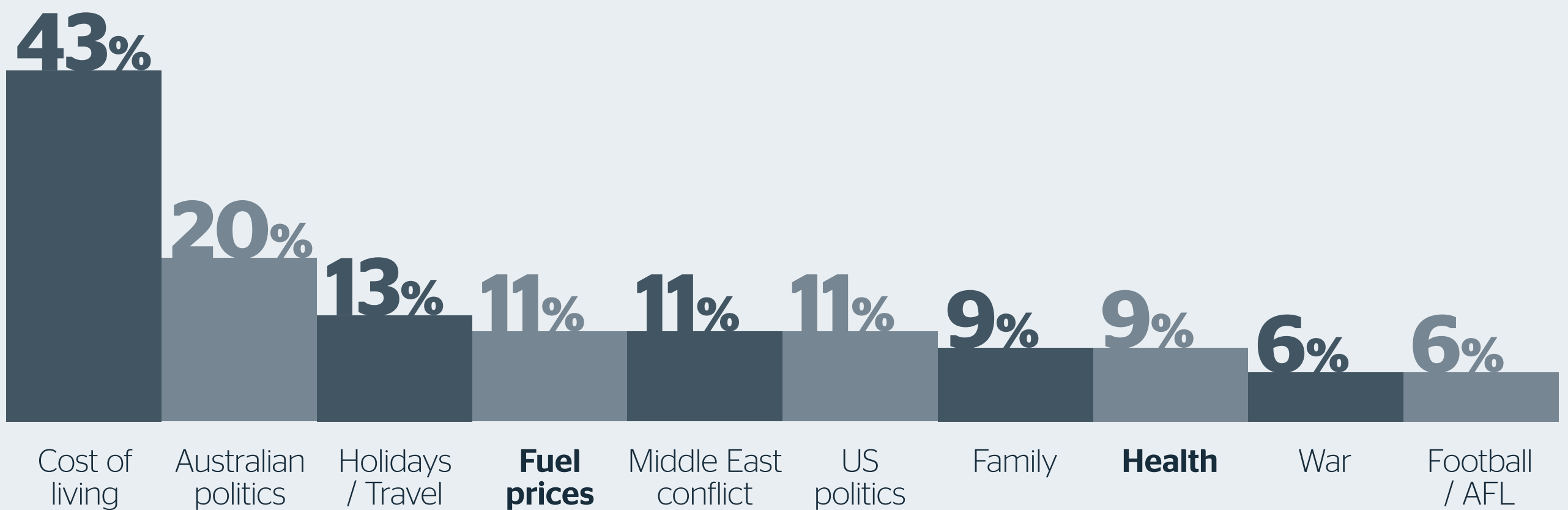

Household conversations

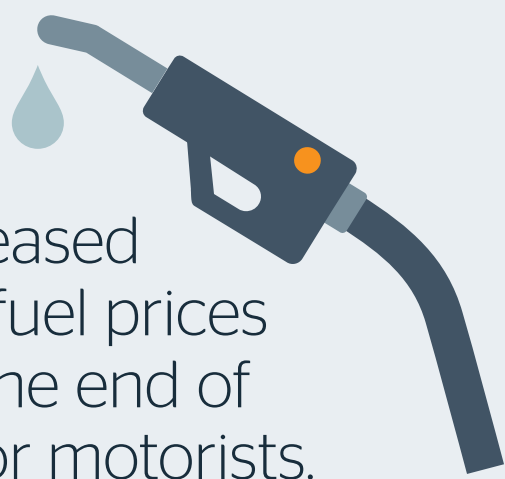
What are members talking about at home?

- » Employment prospects

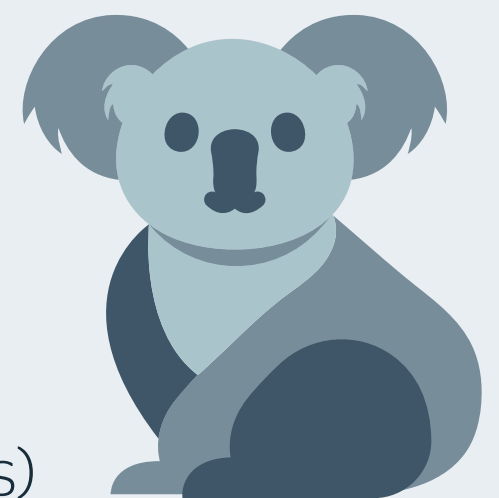


Community Volunteering
