



## A message from the RAC President

### Your chance to vote for a stronger RAC

From humble beginnings, RAC has been evolving for 120 years.

Founded by a group of motoring enthusiasts in 1905 – we're now proud to represent more than 1.3 million members through our advocacy and community initiatives, supported by diverse member services including motoring, insurance, travel, parks and resorts, home security, and personal finance.

Since 2017, we've been taking steps to modernise your RAC so we can deliver the best services for members well into the future.

The improvements to our governance, recently supported by members at the Special General Meeting in June this year, were an important step in our journey. We're now asking you to support us as we take the next steps in enhancing the governance of RAC.

These steps include a Special Resolution, set out in the Notice of Annual General Meeting (AGM) which will strengthen RAC's governance and I strongly encourage you to vote in favour of this resolution (being Item 9 of business at the AGM).

In short, we're asking eligible Voting Members to vote in favour of modernising RAC by:

- changing our legal structure from an incorporated association under the *Associations Incorporation Act* (WA) to a company limited by guarantee under the *Corporations Act* (Cth), and
- operating under a new constitution that complies with the *Corporations Act*.

These changes are necessary because RAC has outgrown the *Associations Incorporation Act* – legislation intended to regulate much smaller, local clubs and community organisations in Western Australia.

It's important to highlight that support for this change in governance also means RAC will continue to be a member-owned organisation that exists for members.

Your reason for being an RAC member and the way you interact with us won't change either. Rather, these changes will set RAC up with a more modern and agile structure and bring us in line with most motoring clubs and large mutuals around the country.

These changes are crucially important to securing a stronger future for your RAC – and I strongly urge you to vote in favour of the Special Resolution.
